5. SERVICE PARK

5.1 INFORMATION ABOUT THE SERVICE PARK

5.1.1 SERVICE PARK

Ubicazione: SP1 - Alghero - Banchina Millelire
SP2 - Alghero - Piazzale della Pace

Location: Banchina Millelire e Piazzale della Pace – Alghero

NOTICE: inside the Service Park it is absolutely prohibited to park trolleys, transporters and trailers outside the individual service area. For parking these vehicles competitors have at their disposal the area zona industriale San Marco via Del Progresso (40°39'14.91"N 8°19'22.04"E).

Thank you for your kind cooperation in using this parking area.

Request for additional space has to be made using the form for "Facilities at charge" available on the event website with copy to: n.russo@rallyitalia-sardegna.com by Monday 14 September.

The cost for each additional square meter is: € 50,00 + 22%VAT (where applicable).



5.1.2 ACCESS TO THE SERVICE PARK

Service and Auxiliary car plates needed to enter the Service Park are included in the materials that competitors will receive during the pre-reconnaissance checks. For the entire duration of the Rally, only cars with Service and Auxiliary plates will be allowed to enter the Service Park. No vehicle carrying the Auxiliary or service plate can be parked out of the competitor service area. Any vehicle parked out of the competitor service area will be moved out of the service park at competitor's cost. Plates must be fixed inside the vehicle, on the right side of the windscreen. The Service Park 1 will open for Competitors and Suppliers on Thursday 24 September at 09:00 (upon request only)

5.1.3 JOINT SERVICE AREAS

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. P2, P3 and non priority drivers wishing to have a working area next to another competitor must inform n.russo@rallyitaliasardegna.com by Monday 14 September.

5.1.4 FACILITIES IN THE SERVICE PARK

The organiser will provide the following services to ALL competitors:

- waste collection for mixed waste, oil, paper, etc.;
- public toilets;
- general security in the Service Park area;
- electricity up to 3 Kw;
- water;
- car wash before entering the Service Park.

The organiser can provide at charge the following additional services:

- additional space in the individual service area;
- private security service;
- additional portable toilets inside the Teams' area;
- motorhome waste water emptying;
- electricity over 3 Kw;
- forklift service and sea container handling.

5.2 SERVICE PARK FACILITIES AT CHARGE

5.3 MEDICAL CARE

A First Aid point will be available at the Service Park.

5.4 CAR WASHING

Competitors are NOT allowed to wash cars inside their service areas. The organiser will provide a car washing before the Service Park that will be indicated in the Road Book.

Competitors are NOT allowed to wash spare parts inside their area in the Service Park. Organiser will prepare a dedicated area for washing inside the Service Park that will be indicated in the final layout of the SP.

6. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

6.1 LICENSE

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to obtain the license it is necessary to contact the Italian Ministry of Communication. Nevertheless the Organiser are at competitors disposal for any assistance may be needed. We remind that the use of radio frequencies without license may lead to the prohibition of using the transmitter, as well as a fine and the confiscation of the radio equipment.

7. HELICOPTERS

7.1 REGISTRATION

In order to ensure that air traffic may develop in the best safety conditions and according with the FIA Safety Regulations and the Italian Air Traffic Authority, all helicopters wishing to flying over the area of Rally Italia Sardegna during the event, must register at the Rally Organisation. Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopter areas or other sites within the competition zone

7.2 REGISTRATION FORM AND PROCEDURES

Application form has to be sent to the Rally Office (www.rallyitaliasardegna.com) by Monday 21 September.

7.3 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

The Organisers require payment of an administrative fee as refund related to the costs incurred for the management of services to commercial helicopters and teams helicopters exceeding the unit included in the WRC package. The amount is € 3.050,00 (€ 2.500,00 + € 550,00 VAT 22%) for each helicopter. Fee must be paid by Bank Transfer to:

7.4 BRIEFING

Attendance to the pilots briefing in Rally HQ on Thursday 1 October at 13:30, is compulsory for all pilots. Failing to attend the briefing will imply the cancellation from the registered helicopters list and consequently the prohibition to over-fly the rally area. After the briefing all pilots will get three stickers with identification numbers that must be placed on the bottom and on both sides of the helicopter for the entire duration of the event.

12. WASTE COLLECTION REGULATION

This year will be carried out the sorting waste collection of household and special waste with precise rules that each competitor must follow as per 12.29 of the Supplementary Regulation.

MUNICIPAL WASTE

The Organizers will give each competitor a set composed by 5 bins and several bags to be put inside each bin, with different colors depending on the kind of waste. The bins will have different colors depending on the waste they are supposed to contain as per the table here below:

WASTE	COLOR OF THE BIN
Mixed municipal waste	Grey
Biodegradable kitchen and canteen waste	Brown
Plastic and aluminum	Yellow
Paper and Cardboard	White
Glass	Green

All competitors must make the waste disposal following the table above described with the five different categories. The Organizers will provide to collect the waste from the different stands twice or three times a day depending on the necessity. Here below it is explained in detail what can be put in each bin.

MIXED MUNICIPAL WASTE , NOT RECYCLABLE - grey bin

- Not usable clothes;
- absorbents, cotton swabs, cotton used, face or body cream, disposable blades,
- dental floss, rubber and latex gloves, gums to wipe or chewed;
- glazed paper, sliced ham/salami or cheesed paper, greasy, dirty glue or other chemicals, charcoal and wax paper, photo paper, greasy pizza box;
- greasy sponges and rags;
- rubber bands, sticker labels, tape;
- ashes, lighters, jewelry, buttons, bags, candles, mirrors, leather belts and leather in general, shoe laces, gaskets, glasses, crystal objects, (really of little size, without electric and electronic parts, and anyway not usable);
- compact Disc (CD), Digital Versatile Disc (DVD), Blue Ray Disc (BRD), Video Home System (VHS);
- every other thing not provided in the other categories.

BIODEGRADABLE KITCHEN AND CANTEEN WASTE AND BIOCOMPOSTABLE - brown bin

- raw or cooked food leftovers, including spoiled (meat, eggs, small bones, bread, etc.);
- eggs shells , dried fruits, seafood and crustaceans;
- fish and fish bones;
- vegetables, fruits and fruit skins;
- coffee and filters of tea;
- white napkins, tissues and absorbing paper;
- matches and toothpicks;

PLASTIC AND CANS - yellow bins



- empty and well-rinsed containers for turpentine, acetone, alcohol, bleach, ammonia and detergent;
- cosmetic containers and toothpaste tubes, mayonnaise and creams (empty),
- personal deodorants (spray and stick);
- polystyrene packaging and fruit and vegetable net;
- Aluminum containers and cans containing no toxic products (lacquers, etc.);
- plastic, steel or small containers, vessels or tanks (small for home use);
- Tin cans, cans and cans for oils, soft drinks and food preservatives;
- Dishes, glasses and cutlery are used and disposed of without food residue;
- coat racks and hangers;
- empty blister, Screw and crown caps, metal and plastic lids;
- bags, shopper, envelopes and bags or food pans (pasta, salad, etc.)
- foil paper and aluminum foil (clean);
- plastic boxes, plastic films (pluriball) for food, cellophane and plastic film;
- nylon made of plastic and metal packaging for packing, plastic trays and plastic or polystyrene jars for foodstuffs empty;

PAPER AND CARDBOARD - white bin

- paper, cardboard, cardboard, trays and sheets or paper or cardboard bags;
- boxes and cardboard (empty boxes of pasta, food pans, eggs, etc.);
- Pizza boxes if not too dirty;
- Shoppers and tablecloths in paper (if not too dirty);
- Books, newspapers, magazines, photocopies, notebooks;
- Cardboard and paperboard packaging (small size);
- Empty containers in TetraPak, pure-Pak for beverages, milk juices, fruit juice, wine, cooking cream, etc.;

GLASS (EMPTY CONTAINERS) - green bin

- perfumes;
- jars;
- bottles;

SPECIAL WASTE

As regards special waste, an ecological area has been set up within the service park (see annex to RG2 - layout of the service park) in which the following special waste can be disposed of:

Car batteries

Lamps

Engine oil

Other emulsions

Oil filters

absorbents, filter materials (including oil filters not otherwise specified), wiping cloths, protective clothing contaminated by hazardous substances. The used tyres must be disposed of by the suppliers, in case if this is not possible must be deposited in a special designated area of within the ecological area recycling centre. Competitors who will need to dispose of special waste above listed above are obliged to must notify the responsible person in charge Mr. Fabio Frascioni, tel. +39 339 740 12 72, mail: f.frasconi@rallyitaliasardegna.com. A person of the staff will then accompany the applicant to the Ecological area recycling centre located inside within the service park, where they can may dispose of the special waste depositing by placing it in the dedicated designated container.

WASTE WATER

DISCHARGES OF DOMESTIC WASTE WATER

1) It is forbidden to discharge domestic waste water from toilets, kitchens or washbasins sinks into the ground or into the sea in general. The same Such waste water must be collected in special designated private tanks private OR made in tanks provided available by the organization, which will empty them three times a day.

WASHING OF THE CAR OR PARTS OF IT

- 1) It is forbidden to wash cars or part of it inside the stands.
- 2) For the cars have been provided a Car Wash indicated in the general map of Alghero.
- 3) Spare parts and other parts of the cars (e.g. rims, etc.) may be washed in the appropriate area (see annex to RG 2-layout of the service park) in which washing tanks have been prepared.

During the set-up, operation and dismantling phases of the Service Park, Rally Village, Podium Area and any other technical areas of the Event, all Teams, suppliers, operators and any other persons authorised to access or operate within the aforementioned areas shall comply with all applicable Italian laws and regulations in force, with particular reference to the provisions concerning occupational health and safety under Italian Legislative Decree No. 81 of 9 April 2008, as subsequently amended and supplemented, as well as with all organisational, technical and safety instructions issued by the Organiser.

In particular, during set-up and dismantling activities, where applicable, the obligations relating to cooperation and coordination and the management of risks arising from interference between different activities shall be ensured in accordance with Article 26 of Italian Legislative Decree No. 81/2008, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

Within the scope of their respective responsibilities and the functions assigned to them by the Organiser, any operational instructions and requirements issued by Alessandra Capece, Alessandro Tanguenza, Paolo Senesi, Antonio Rubattu and Samantha Fois shall be deemed to constitute official operational instructions of the Organiser and shall be strictly observed and implemented by Teams, suppliers, operators and any other persons present within the relevant areas.

Within the scope of their respective responsibilities, such requirements may concern the use and occupation of allocated spaces, the correct positioning of structures, vehicles and equipment, internal traffic circulation and access, the maintenance and clearance of routes and safety areas, as well as compliance with the technical, organisational and safety conditions established for the various areas of the Event.

Any failure to comply with the instructions and requirements issued shall be formally reported to the Clerk of the Course.
